What is 'Listening Ears'? Our 'Listening Ears' program is a weekly one-to-one mentoring and support session for Primary School children who may be facing challenging times. These are purposeful sessions in which a trained individual gives

time to listen and support your child while trying to help them work through their own challenges and enable them to make positive decisions in the future.


Who is it for? 'Listening Ears' is ideal for children who need a little extra time to talk through the challenges they are facing. This could be anything from a recent family separation, anxiety, bereavement or any other challenges that may affect their day to day life.

Who are the support workers? All our support workers are trained to listen and understand children while being supportive of their needs. Although they are not counsellors or therapists they are able to provide a safe place for a child to talk through the challenges they may face. All our support workers have passed a current DBS check and always work within the school and Kids UK safeguarding policies.









When do they happen? The one-to-one support sessions take place in school during the school day. They typically involve seeing a child for approximately 30 minutes per week and would usually continue for a term or longer if needed.



Once the one-to-ones have been approved by Kids UK and the school, your child's support worker will liaise with the parent/ carers and the school to arrange your child sessions.

Involvement from parents/carers As an organisation we feel the best way to support a child is to work along side the parents/carers as well as linking

with the child's school. Therefore a parent/carers would need to complete our referral form and once it has been accepted we will contact the them along with the school to let you know when the one-to-one support sessions will

start as well as maintaining communication while we are working with your child.

How much does it cost?

Our sessions cost Kids UK in the region on of £1000 per term. However due to the kind donations and grant funding, we are able to cover two-thirds of this cost. We believe all children should have access to these sessions regardless of their financial status. With this in mind, Kids UK has chosen not to charge parents/carers for these sessions and instead we link closely with the school to raise the remaining funds by encouraging them to host a charity fundraising day/event.
